



## HVAC/Plumber LPG Certification:

As of May 22, 2008, if you are a Journeyman Plumber or hold a current RMGA Certificate you can receive your HVAC/Plumber LPG Certification **without testing**. This is **not** applicable to Residential Journeyman Plumber Classifications.

**Your company must be licensed BEFORE an individual licenses (employee) can be issued.**

### **FEES:**

**Class III LPG Certificate - \$105.00** (Class III: A business not engaged in the sale of LPG, but engaged in the sale and installation of gas appliances, or LPG systems.)

**HVAC/Plumber LPG Certificate - \$40.00 per person**

### **ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL DATE:**

Original LPG certificates shall be valid for one year from the date of issuance. Thereafter, each LPG certificate shall be renewed annually and renewals thereof shall be valid from for one year from issuance.

### **RENEWAL DATE:**

Application for renewal shall be made on forms provided by the Division.

### **RE-EXAMINATION:**

Every holder of a valid LPG Certificate shall take a re-examination every five years from the date of original certificate issuance, to comply with the provisions of Section 4.3 of these rules as follows:

### **RE-EXAMINATION:**

Every holder of a valid LPG Certificate shall take a re-examination every five years from the date of original certificate issuance, **-OR-**

As required in Section 4.7 of these rules, those applicants that provide the Division with written verification of the completion of **40 hours of continuing training** over the previous five-year period shall have the requirement for re-examination waived.
